Reflect

The cacophony of the world and my own noisy mind can sometimes make me feel like I'm spinning out of control—in a constant state of reaction. I've found that ushering stillness, inviting silence, and opening my senses to receiving the sounds of the day—whether it is a song on the radio or being present with the sounds of creation—can help me to “open the ears of my heart” and become re-centered, reminded that all around God is singing a song for me to receive.

Counters - This ministry assists in the tally of monies collected at Mass each week. Although we do receive weekly donations from parishioners through our online giving, for those who wish to donate directly during Mass collections requires two individuals to reconcile the checks and cash received. The counters meet at 9:00AM on Mondays in the church office. The time commitment is usually one Monday a month (Tuesday if Monday is a bank holiday) and the task usually takes one hour. (If a different time or day would work better, please reach out to the office to inquire).

Sacristans - Sacristans serve the parish in a very special way by carefully making ready what is required for all liturgical celebrations. Persons who serve in this ministry ensure that all vessels, linens and other items are properly prepared for the liturgy. The time commitment requires 15-30 minutes prior to Mass and 15-30 minutes after Mass once or twice a month.

Lectors/Readers - Anyone can be a reader. There is minimal training needed to proclaim God's Word during Mass. Schedules are created quarterly and in most instances readers will only need to read once a month. It is at your discretion whether you prefer to read at Saturday or Sunday Mass.

Choir - Do people turn to you and say, “You should join the choir” or do you just love to sing? Are you playing an instrument or have you played one in the past? We invite you to join our music ministry on Saturday evening or Sunday morning. Come as often or as little as you can.

We provide mentoring, fellowship and an opportunity to praise God in song. Please feel free to talk to any choir member after Mass or anytime.
