### **Our Lady Helps Us Grow Strong**

A mother helps her children to grow up and wants them to grow strong. That is why she teaches them not to be lazy and not to sink into a comfortable lifestyle, contenting oneself with possessions. The mother takes care that

her children develop better, that they grow strong, capable of accepting responsibilities, of engaging in life, of striving for great ideals.

The Gospel of St. Luke tells us that in the family of Nazareth, Jesus "grew and became strong, filled with wisdom and the favor of God was upon Him" (2:40). Our Lady does just this for us. She helps us to grow as human beings and in the faith. To be strong and never to fall into the temptation of being human beings and Christians in a superficial way, but to live responsibly, to strive ever higher.

#### Mother Mary Help Us

The Virgin Mary teaches us what it means to live in the Holy Spirit and what it means to accept the news of God in our lives.
