**EUCCHARISTIC ADORATION**

*(continued from previous bulletin)*

The Lord's vision of us is always primary. Beloved, sinful creatures that we are, we tend to hide from Him. The call of Eucharistic Adoration is, among other things, a call to present ourselves to Him. The key is to let Him see us as we are. It is His perspective, not our own, that is the beginning of true life.

As we work to let ourselves be present to the Lord at Eucharistic Adoration, we may meditate on the ways in which the Lord has looked upon others. There are a surprising number of moments in the Gospels where the way Jesus looked at someone is highlighted. As we come to recognize how the Lord looks upon His people and what that look means, we may slowly recognize ourselves as the ones He is yearning to see. His look is not always comforting, but it is always true. And the way to true happiness begins with discovering ourselves as the ones who are looked upon by the Lord.

Perhaps you would like to choose one of the following ways that Jesus has looked upon His people to focus your mind, attune your heart, and shape your imagination during your time at Eucharistic Adoration. You may select a different way each day, or return time and again to one that is particularly fruitful for you. The gift and the challenge is to grow in trust that the Lord who looked upon each of these people in these particular ways is the same Lord who looks upon you in the Blessed Sacrament, right here and right now.
