Living Holiness

The call to holiness is a call to love, both God and neighbor (see Mt 22:36-40). "We are all called to be holy by living our lives with love and by bearing witness in everything we do, wherever we find ourselves" (14), the pope says. Or as Pope Benedict XVI said (as quoted by Pope Francis), "Holiness is nothing other than charity lived to the full."

While the pope acknowledges that holiness comes in all shapes and sizes, he proposes some basic characteristics of love that form its foundation: growth in holiness through consistency and dedication in small gestures of love in daily human life and relations (see 16) and imitating the self-sacrificial love of Christ (20).

One of the document's hallmarks—indeed, even the source of its title—is found in its lengthy discourse on the Beatitudes from Jesus' Sermon on the Mount (see Mt 5:3-12), which the pope calls "a Christian's identity card." They present us with a portrait of Jesus, he says, "Which we are called to reflect in our daily lives" (63).
